The 2020 Bond has funded the conversion of Harrison Park K-8 to a Middle School. While not a full modernization, the work will significantly upgrade the school. The project will provide students a robust middle school experience by upgrading the facilities to enhance academics.

Construction impacts on the school during the 2023-24 school year

- Safety is our number one priority.
- Construction activity is separated by barriers or fencing so that students will not come in contact with construction activities.
- Dust and debris are safely contained in sealed-off areas and will not enter the school.
- Although there will be some construction noise, the loudest activities are scheduled to take place outside of school hours.

Work underway this year


- New heating and cooling system and fire sprinklers.
- New STEAM lab, science classrooms, art classroom, extended learning space.
- Remodel, and repair of Counseling, Health, & Special Education, Gyms, and Dance Studio.
- Reorganize of the NW classroom area for greater functionality.
- Upgrade existing restrooms, classrooms, and corridors.

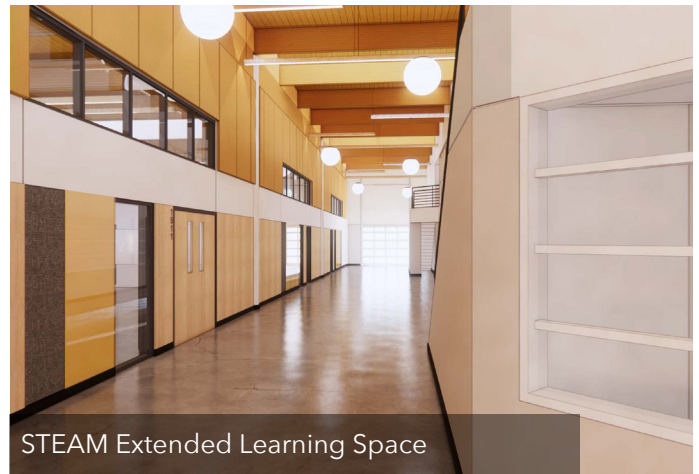
Work began in 2022 and will complete in the fall of 2024.

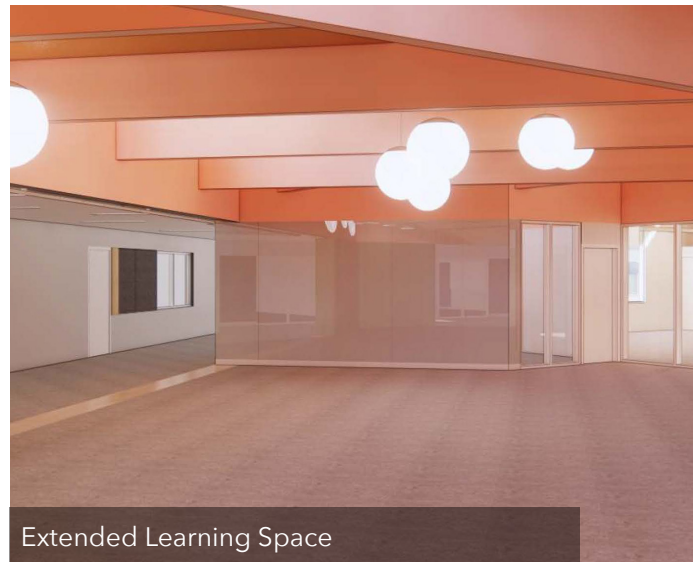
