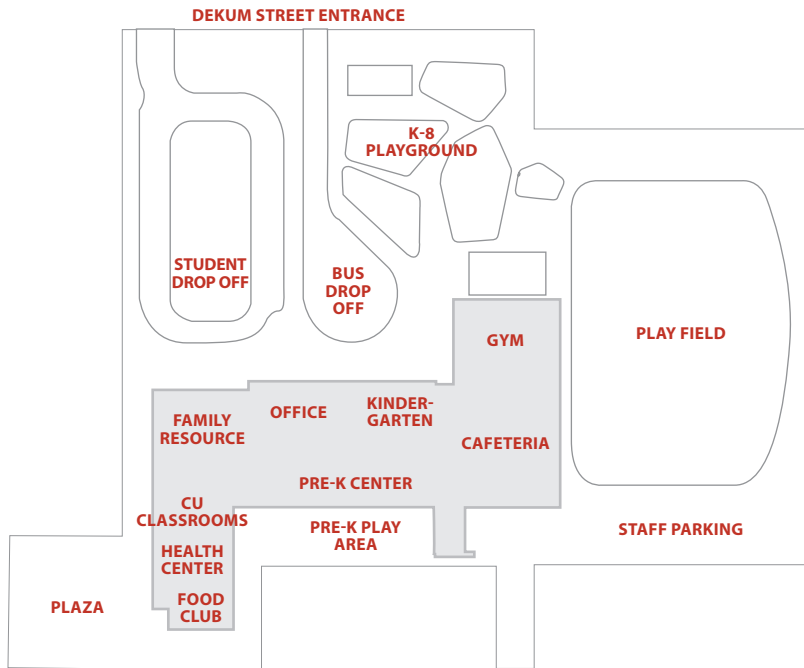

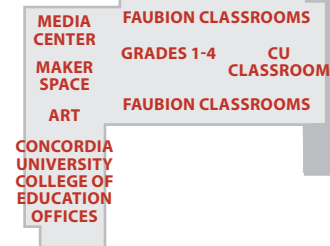

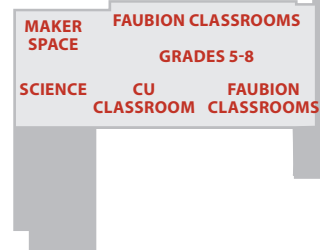

New School Layout

There are many exciting changes in the new Faubion PK-8. The main Faubion entrance and drop off area is now on Dekum street. The first floor includes a "Welcome Hall" and "Main Street" featuring the school's main office, family resource room, food club, and Kaiser Permanente 3 to PhD® Wellness Center. The first floor will also house the early childhood education center and kindergarten classes. The cafeteria and gym are located on the east side of the building, also on the first floor.

The second floor holds grades 1-4, a state of the art Maker Space, art classroom, design technology studio and a two-story library.

Classes for grades 5-8 are on the third floor, along with a double Maker Space and a new science lab built to high school standards.

Fun Facts

- The building meets the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED GOLD standards using solar energy for electricity and hot water.
- Bricks from the old Faubion were used to create the new monument sign on Dekum.
- The sequoia tree from the old campus was milled into new playground benches.
