# Help Us Create a Modernized Jefferson High School





## All New Jefferson High plan details

PPS is moving forward with the design of an all-new Jefferson High School to be built at the North end of the campus with construction beginning in the summer of 2025. The school will feature specialized instructional spaces for Jeff's unique Career Technical Education [CTE] programs. Other highlights include a new 1,000 seat Jefferson theater, a centrally located student commons, plus dedicated spaces for local community organizations and a new teen parent center. The track and field will be relocated and reoriented, with new grandstands. Plus, brand new baseball and softball fields with new turf and dugouts will be added.

Students and staff will remain on the campus during the four-year construction process.

## **Project History**

In 2021, Comprehensive Planning for Jefferson began. During two years of planning and extensive community engagement, PPS developed a plan that included modernizing the original 1909 building and building new facilities around it. This plan kept students on site during construction. However, in-depth cost analysis in 2023 revealed that seismically upgrading the existing four-story unreinforced masonry building, while keeping students on site, would greatly exceed the budget. A new approach was needed.

In December 2023, the Board of Education called for a full reassessment of the Jefferson modernization plans with the following criteria.

- Keep students & staff on the Jefferson campus during construction.
- Include a targeted student enrollment of 1,700.
- Demolish the 1909 building and build a new building.

On April 2nd, 2024, the Project Team presented a revised plan for an all-new Jefferson High School building constructed at the north end of the campus along Killingsworth. This plan will cost \$491 million which is \$125 million more than the \$366 million provided by the 2020 School Improvement Bond. To complete the project, funding will be required from an upcoming School Improvement Bond.

- Learn how the landscape and fields will be used.
- Determine the new building's interior space scale and experience.
- Develop a shared sustainability vision for the new school.
