3.10.015-AD Registered Sex Offenders on School Property:

No registered sex offender shall come on any school property. If any person believes a registered sex offender has been present or is present on school property, that person should immediately inform the principal.

If the principal is uncertain whether the individual is a registered sex offender, the principal shall determine with certainty whether the individual is a registered sex offender by contacting the School Resource Officer. If the individual is a registered sex offender and is then on school property, the principal shall direct the individual to leave the premises immediately. The principal should request assistance from local law enforcement authorities if the offender resists the principal's directive.

If a registered sex offender has violated the prohibition from coming on school property, the principal shall immediately report the violation to the Area Director, who may confer with legal counsel to take appropriate action, which may include issuing a notice of trespass order.

A parent who is a registered sex offender shall contact his or her child's building principal by phone, U.S. Mail, or e-mail to ascertain alternative methods for carrying out school business related to his or her student off school property.

This Administrative Directive does not apply to students. Principals shall contact their Area Director if a student is a registered sex offender.
