

5.20.150-P Professional Development

- (1) The Board recognizes the need to establish a continuing professional development (CPD) program for all licensed staff in order to enhance professional performance, promote achievement of high standards for all students and assist employees in meeting the licensure requirements of the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC). To this end, a qualified district CPD program shall be developed in writing, reviewed and approved by the Board. The superintendent shall ensure that the qualified district CPD program submitted for Board approval complies with the purposes and standards set forth in OAR 584-090-0001 and 584-090-0020.
- (2) Educators may choose to participate in the district qualified CPD plan or to develop an Individual Continuing Professional Development plan, as provided by TSPC Professional Rules.
- (3) The superintendent or designee is authorized to develop rules and procedures, staff handbooks and other related materials as may be necessary to implement the district's qualified CPD program.
