Student Tech Devices

Every PPS student grades three to twelve has access to a free tech device to access digital curriculum and online resources. If your student needs a device, please contact your school. You will be expected to sign an User Agreement acknowledging that you received a device.

Please note that PPS is removing the \$20 device self-insurance fee that was previously announced by school communities. Families will not be asked nor are required to pay this fee and those families that have paid this fee will receive a refund. Depending on how a payment was made will determine how the refund is issued; so our school and district teams will be working diligently over the next few weeks to process.
